




Finger Joint Bit




A finger joint is one of the strongest joints in woodworking. As it effectively triples the surface area of the glue joint, it is nearly indestructible. Ideal for joining wood end-to-end as well as edge-to-edge. Rout one workpiece face up, the other face down. When the bit height is correct, the two pieces should slide together with their faces perfectly flush.


